

Introducing i-Ready®

A New Learning Tool for Clover School District

- WHO?** Kindergarten through Eighth Grade Students and Teaching Staff
- WHAT?** i-Ready delivers both diagnostic assessments and leveled learning opportunities based on student performance in mathematics and English language arts. Once the diagnostic is complete, a personalized pathway is prescribed for the student. The data collected is nationally normed and is reported by standard domain. It can be used by teaching staff to tailor classroom learning experiences to meet student needs.
- WHEN?** Diagnostic assessments will be given in the fall, winter, and spring to collect data for progress monitoring and adjusting instructional content. The assessment will take up to 100 minutes per content area but can be taken in sections. Students are encouraged to work on lessons for 30-60 minutes each week in both content areas. This can be in as short as 15 minute sessions.
- WHERE?** Students can access the i-Ready platform from any web-enabled device.
- HOW?** Students will log in through Clever, a single sign on tool, with the same credentials they use for various other district tools.
- WHY?** This tool will give us valuable data to know what students know and can do and it will provide lessons to help students continually grow.

Technical Notes:

- * Students will login through the Clever app or website and then choose i-Ready app in the portal.
- * Diagnostic assessments will be the first things students see. Before starting the test, students will be shown a video about how and why to do their best as well as a tutorial for any tools used in the upcoming test. There is a break given after each standard domain. If the connection is broken or a student needs to stop in the middle of a section, the test will resume upon return to the tool.
- * After the diagnostic students will see an area for Teacher-Assigned Lessons and an area called My Path for math and ELA.
