**CHILD FIND** is a screening process to assist families in identifying children with special needs who may require specialized instruction. It is available free of cost through Clover School District for children ages 3 to 21 residing within the school district.

# CHILD FIND REFERRALS

## How Do I Refer a Child for Special Services?

Children, ages 3 to 5, who are not enrolled in Clover Schools, or students who receive private or homeschooling may be referred by a parent/guardian by calling the Clover School District Special Services office at 803-810-8400. Parent/Guardian must supply a certified birth certificate, legal guardianship, an immunization record and two proofs of residency. School-aged children who are already enrolled in a Clover school program may be referred by contacting the School Intervention Team (SIT) at the child's home school.

## Areas of concern to consider for screening:

- Child does not talk or cannot be understood
- Child is uncoordinated or has difficulty in walking or using hands
- Child has extreme emotional responses and does not show an interest in social relationships
- Child does not respond to his/her name or show ability to follow a simple command
- School-aged child is not making academic progress in the general curriculum
