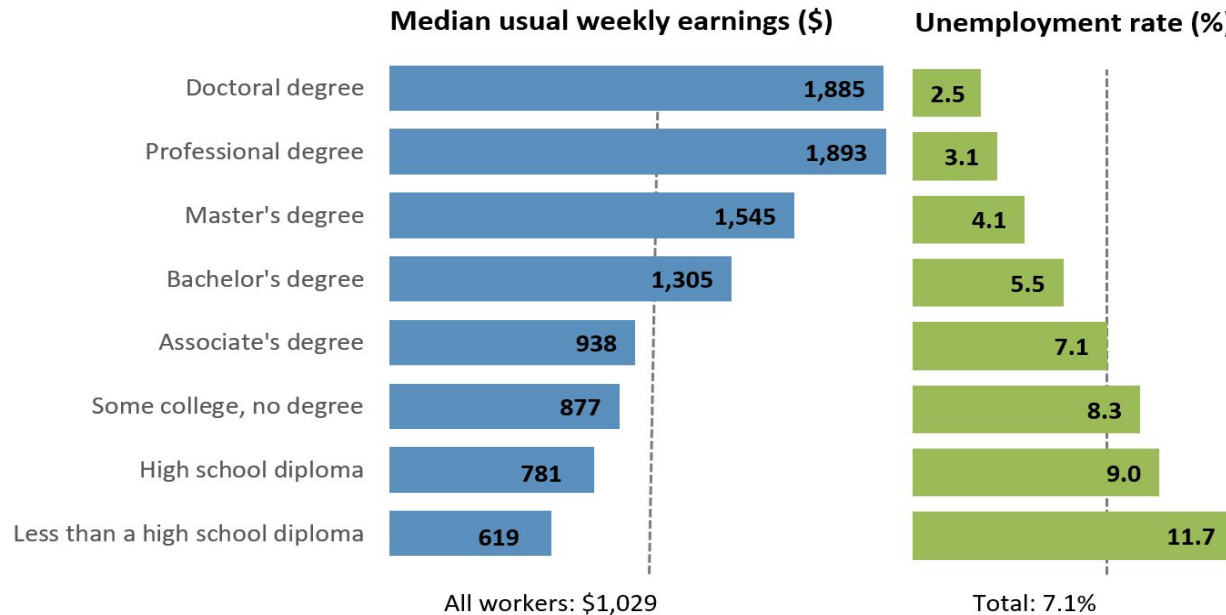



APPLY – 3 PARTS TO A COMPLETE COLLEGE APPLICATION

1. Student application

Use the college website OR Common App OR Coalition

2. Transcript package - request through your Naviance account

- Transcript
- Secondary school report ...completed by your counselor about you
- School profile
- Any letters of recommendation you've asked teachers to write

One time \$5 fee payable in the Counseling Center to send unlimited transcript packages

3. Test scores

- Must be sent directly from College Board or ACT

Part 3 - Test Scores

Test scores are optional for many colleges.

A quick guideline – if your test score is within the 50% range or over, you may want to submit it. If it is below the average, consider applying as test optional.

Notes for the SAT and ACT for seniors

- You need to activate your account on the ACT and/or SAT site to send your scores from the test you took at CHS.
- We cannot send your test scores to colleges. You must log in to your testing account and send your scores
- Most colleges will accept scores from the November or December test administration for admission purposes.
- Students have until June to qualify for LIFE and Palmetto Fellows Scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED BY SOUTH CAROLINA

Hope

Four year college

3.0 SC GPA

\$2600 for one year

With a 3.0 GPA at the end of one year, Hope will convert to LIFE

LIFE - two year college

Two Year College

3.0 SC GPA

\$5000 per year

Good for two years with a 3.0 GPA each year

LIFE - four year college

Four Year College

3.0 SC GPA plus top 30%
OR 1100 SAT/
22 ACT

\$5000 per year

Good for four years with a 3.0 GPA each year

Palmetto Fellows

Four Year College

Top 6% of class plus a
27 ACT/ 1200 SAT OR
4.0 SC GPA/
1400/31

\$6700 the first year and
\$7500 each year thereafter

These are for SC residents attending SC colleges and students will only receive one scholarship.

OVERVIEW OF SENIOR TIMELINE

All Year

- Read your emails daily
- Talk with colleges, recruiters, employers
- Maintain strong attendance
- Keep up your GPA for scholarships! 3.0 SC UGP is required for the LIFE scholarship.

Fall

- Attend IGP conference
- Take SAT or ACT, if needed, to qualify for LIFE or Palmetto Fellows
- Apply to colleges (many deadlines of 12/1)
- Take ASVAB if needed
- Winter Graduation for some seniors

Spring

- Review offers from colleges
- Bring your offers to the Counseling Center
- Take SAT or ACT, if needed, to qualify for LIFE or Palmetto Fellows
- Fill out your senior graduation survey
- May 1 – Decision Day! Let colleges know your decision.
- Graduate!
