Subject: Grades on District Apps

In April of this year, the South Carolina State Board of Education voted to adopt the 10-point grading scale. As of August 22, 2016, PowerSchool, a statewide computer software used to track grades, has yet to be updated through the state department to reflect this change.

Please be advised that until this is corrected at the state level, your student's numerical grades are correct, but may not necessarily correspond to the correct letter grade per the new grading scale. As soon as an update is made to the software, we will send out additional communication to notify you of the change.

An example of correct numerically but not by letter: A 92 listed as a "B" will be an "A" when the program is properly updated.
