

Early Childhood Student Assurances for Technology Acceptable Use

Clover School District will provide students with access to the Internet and a variety of applications to enhance student learning within the classroom using technology. Internet services are to be used in a responsible, efficient, ethical, and legal manner. In order to participate in the use of technology, all students must agree to abide by the generally accepted rules of use found in the following statements:

1. I will use technology to help me learn.
2. I am responsible for the computer or iPad assigned to me. I will keep it safe and tell my teacher if anything bad happens.
3. I will keep my iPad in its protective case and carry it with two hands.
4. I will not use mean or bad words.
5. I will never give my address or phone number on the computer or iPad.
6. I will make sure my behavior does not hurt others.
7. I will always follow my teacher's directions when using the iPad or computer. I will only do things my teacher says I can do. I will only go to websites that my teacher says I can.

Students not following the guidelines above may be given restricted use of the technology in the future.
