Minutes from January 18th, 2019 meeting were approved.

## 1. President's Report

- -Dina Vacho shared her design for lounge area charging stations and tables/table concept and provided details regarding pricing. Details included but were not limited to; spill-proof ledges, ability for 20 kids to charge devices at once, custom design, and that they are constructed of steel. Based on Dina's research the tables are cost effective when taking quality and durability into account.
- -It was voted to purchase one table (prototype) and put it in the 8th grade lounge to determine whether PTSO will purchase the same tables for the 7th and 6th grade lounges. If it is decided that the design isn't ideal for use with all grade levels the prototype can be placed in the library and new designs can be considered.
- -Saysha Mei coordinated and confirmed food truck for Academic Challenge spectators. The district is expecting approximately 100 spectators. Saysha is going to get a menu with pricing so that PTSO can help to promote it.
- -General discussion regarding vaping incidents at the middle took place. PTSO acknowledged the importance of talking with our children at home about the risks of vaping.
- -Spirit wear should be in this week. Profit details will be shared at the next meeting. A suggestion was made to sell spirit wear at 2019-2020 registration.
- -The lacrosse team is using Fan Club for supplying their spirit wear. A suggestion was made to explore options for using them in the future for OMS spirit wear.
- -Melissa Coverdale is organizing a lunch for BEA in March.

#### 2. Treasurer's Report
